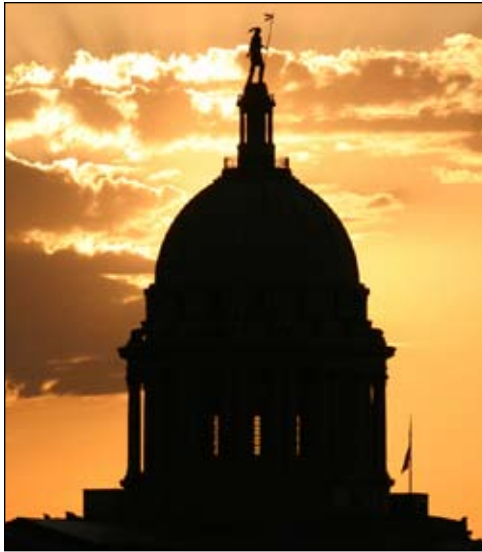


# March 2010 Doctor of the Day Month at the State Capitol



The Oklahoma Osteopathic Association (OOA) will sponsor the Doctor of the Day Program during the month of March 2010 at the Oklahoma State Capitol. This is the 36th year osteopathic physicians have provided this service at the State Capitol's First Aid Station during the legislative session. Physicians are supported by a nurse and a medical student from the Oklahoma State University Center for Health Sciences College of Osteopathic Medicine.

The Doctor of the Day program gives DOs an opportunity to bring osteopathic medicine to policy makers and to see their House and Senate members at work.

Physicians are needed to serve as Doctor of the Day during March on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays from 8:30 am - 4:00 pm; and on Thursdays from 8:30 am - noon. Each doctor can expect to see approximately 15-20 patients.
